Short Row Hat

A skacel collection, Inc. download pattern



SKILL LEVEL: Easy
SIZE AND MATERIALS:

One Size - 132 yds or 2 balls.

Featured Yarn: Cambada by Schulana, 100% Pure New Merino

Wool - 66 yds / 50g. Hat shown in Color #193.

<u>Also required</u>: 20" addi Turbo® circular in size 9 mm (approx US 13); and tapestry needle.

All yarn and needles distributed by skacel collection, Inc.

GAUGE:

11 sts and 18 rows = $4" \times 4"$ in St st.

To save time, check your gauge and read all instructions thoroughly before beginning.

INSTRUCTIONS:

Using scrap yarn, CO 20 sts. Switch to working yarn.

Row 1: Edge st, knit to last st, edge st.
Row 2: Edge st, purl to last st, edge st.

Row 3: Edge st, k16, w/t (sl1, bring working yarn forward, slip st back to left needle, turn).

Row 4 (and all even rows): Purl to last st, edge st.

Row 5: Edge st, k12, w/t.
Row 7: Edge st, k10, w/t.
Row 9: Edge st, k9, w/t.

Note: When working a previously wrapped st, work wrap, together with wrapped stitch, thus hiding the wrap.

Row 11: Edge st, k11, w/t. Row 13: Edge st, k15, w/t. Row 15: Rep Row 1. Row 16: Rep Row 2.

Rep Rows 1 - 16. 6x.

Remove scrap yarn and move "live" sts onto a 2nd needle. Using Three Needle Bind Off, join ends.

With purl side facing, pick up 54 sts evenly around wide edge.

Round 1: *K3, p3, rep from * to end of round.

Rep Round 1 till brim meas 2", then work 4 rounds in St st.

Bind off, allowing edge to roll.

Pom:

To make pom, cut one strand of yarn approx 8" long and lay on a piece of cardboard 2" wide. Wrap remaining yarn around cardboard over strand, then tie strand together tightly. Cut wraps on opposite side of tie, and then trim to make pom even. Sew ends to top of hat.

Edge stitch: Knit first stitch of row, and with yarn in front, slip last stitch of row.
