

HOW TO USE THIS GUIDEBOOK



This *Guidebook* will lead you through exercises and activities that will help you thrive as a disciple of Jesus. Check out these tips for success:

- GOD IS LOVING!—He cares about people (Jeremiah 31:3).


THE TRINITY & wants
