

HOW TO USE THIS GUIDEBOOK



This **Guidebook** will lead you through exercises and activities that will help you thrive as a disciple of Jesus. Check out these tips for success:

- **Plan it out**—Establish a schedule that works for you. Choose a convenient 20- to 30-minute time block to work through one **Trail** segment each week. At that rate, you'll finish one **Trail** every month and this **Guidebook** in one year (with four "vacation" weeks).
- **Together, or solo?**—If you are a young hiker, you'll probably want Mom and/or Dad to work through these activities with you. If you're older, you can travel on your own. Either way, keep your parents in the loop about your progress.
- **Trail Check**—The last page of each Trail segment includes:
 -  **Big Idea:** a summary of what you've learned.
 -  **Prayer:** talk with God about what's on your heart.
 -  **Memory Verses:** the Trail Key Verse and four Trail Verses. See page 10 for more information.
 - **Family Time:** an activity or project you can all do together.
- **Decode**—Many activities use Morse code. Find the decoder on the inside-back-cover of this **Guidebook**. Before long, you'll know Morse code like a pro!

- **GOD IS ONE!**—There is only one true God (**Deuteronomy 6:4-5**).
- **GOD IS SUPREME!**—He reigns over everything (**1 Chronicles 29:11**).
- **GOD IS LOVING!**—He cares about people (**Jeremiah 31:3**).

The Bible reveals that God exists as three-in-one or the **Trinity**—Father, Son (Jesus), and Holy Spirit.

▼ Understanding the Trinity can be confusing. This comparison might help: We have **one** sun, but it has **three** different jobs. (Find a **decoder** on the inside-back-cover of this **Guidebook**.)

1. The sun's keeps the planets in place.

(**God the Father** created and rules the universe.)


2. The sun's helps you see.

(**God the Son** is the “light of the world.”)

3. The sun's energy helps things grow.

(**God the Spirit** enables believers to grow in their faith.)

The sun's gravity, light, and heat all come from one source. One sun has three different functions. Similarly, one God exists as three distinct Persons.






