



Every Which Way Scarf

A free download pattern designed by Anne Claxon for **skacel collection, Inc.**



SKILL LEVEL: Easy

YARN WEIGHT: DK / Light Worsted

One Size: Approx 2.75" x 64"

Yarn Requirements:

One ball of Main Yarn (137 yds) and one ball (approx 70 yds) each of Carrying Yarn in 2 Colors (A & B).

Featured Yarn:

Mosco by **Schulana**, 67% Rayon, 20% Mohair, 13% Viscose - 137 yds / 25g. Shown in Main Yarn (Color #25).

Kid-Seta by **Schulana**, 70% Kid Mohair, 30% Silk - 231 yds / 25g. Shown in Carrying Yarn A (#00), and B (#06).

Also required: 24" addi Turbo® circular needle, size 5 mm (approx US 8), or size needed to obtain gauge; tapestry needle.

All yarn and needles distributed by skacel collection, Inc.

GAUGE:

20 sts and 40 rows = 4" x 4" in garter stitch with one strand of Main Yarn and one strand of Carrying Yarn held together.

INSTRUCTIONS:

The scarf is worked with one strand of Main Yarn and one strand of Carrying Yarn held together. Alternate carrying color for each triangle.

Beginning Triangle:

With 1 strand of Main Yarn and 1 strand of Color A, cast on 1 stitch.

Row 1: Kfb = 2 sts.

Row 2: Kfb, knit to end = 3 sts.

Repeat Row 2 until there are 22 sts on the right-hand needle. Turn

Main Triangle: (worked in short rows)

Switch carrying color.

Row 1: Kfb, SSK turn.

Row 2 (and all even-numbered rows): Knit.

Row 3: Kfb, k1, SSK, turn.

Note: The SSK joins the last stitch of the working row with the next st of the previous triangle.

Row 5: Kfb, k2, SSK, turn.

Row 7: Kfb, k3, SSK, turn.

Continue in this manner until the last SSK has been made (the last two stitches of the row) = 22 sts. Turn.

Repeat Main Triangle 17 times (ending on a Color B triangle)

Last Triangle:

Change to Carrying Color A.

Work same as Main Triangle until there are 11 sts on the right-hand needle and 11 sts on the left-hand needle.

Begin Decrease Section:

Row 9: K1, k2tog, knit to last st, SSK, turn.

Row 10 (and all even-numbered rows): Knit.

Repeat these two rows until there are 6 sts remaining.

Row 11: K1, k3tog, turn

Row 12: K2, turn

Row 13: K3tog, turn

Row 14: K1, turn

Row 15: K2tog.

Cut yarn and pull through remaining st. Weave in all ends.

ABBREVIATIONS:

approx approximate(ly)

k knit

k2tog knit 2 stitches together (decreases 1 stitch)

kfb knit into the front and back loop of stitch (increases 1 stitch)

SSK Slip 2 stitches knitwise, one at a time, from the left needle to the right needle then insert the left needle into the front of the slipped stitches and knit them together.

st(s) stitch(es)
