# Sumerino Cabled Hat with Pom

A skacel collection, Inc. Free Download Pattern



**SKILL LEVEL:** Intermediate **YARN WEIGHT:** Worsted

Yarn Requirement: Two balls - 186 yds

Featured Yarn: Sumerino by Schulana, 100% extra fine

Merino, -93 yds / 50g. Shown in Color #12.

**Also required:** 24" addi Turbo® circular needle, size 5.5 mm (approx US 9), or size needled to obtain gauge; cable needle; tapestry needle.

All yarn and needles distributed by skacel collection, Inc.

# **GAUGE:**

17 sts and 24 rows = 4" x 4" in Seed Stitch.

To save time, check your gaugeand read all instructions thoroughly before beginning.

# **Double Seed Stitch:**

**Row 1:** \*K1, p1, repeat from \*.

Row 2 (and all even rows): Work as sts appear.

Row 3: \*P1, k1, repeat from \*.

#### **INSTRUCTIONS:**

Cast on 54 sts. Work the first 23 sts following the chart, cont the rest of the row in Double Seed Stitch pattern. Cont until piece measures 21" from cast-on edge. Bind off on WS. Join bound-off edge to cast-on edge to form tube. Weave a strand of yarn through the Double Seed Stitch edge and tightly pull together to create top of hat.

Create a pom with leftover yarn and attach to hat.

# **ABBREVIATIONS:**

k knitp purlst(s) stitch(es)

1/1 RC Slip 1 stitch to cable needle and hold in back of work, knit

1, then knit stitch from cable needle.

3/3RC slip 3 stitches on cable needle and hold in back of work,


k3, k3 from cable needle.

# **TECHNIQUES:**

**Edge st** knit first stitch of row, and with yarn in front, slip last stitch of row.

# **Cable Chart:**

Work even rows as sts appear.
