GOALS

A. FAITH FAMILY TREE

Every family has a spiritual journey. Your extended family may live close by or members may be scattered across the nation. You may have never heard faith testimonies of aunts, uncles, or grandparents.

B. FAITH STORIES

Your family may have a long history of people who love Jesus, or they may have just a few. Whatever the case, it is encouraging and enlightening to know your family's faith history and to learn about those who have gone before you! Interview a family member and your parents to find out the following (organize what you discover into a report):

- 1. Which of your family members enjoyed a strong faith and followed Jesus?
- 2. How did your parent(s) make a choice to follow Jesus (if relevant)?
- 3. How did their parents (your grandparents) make a choice to follow Jesus (if relevant)?
- 4. To which churches did your believing family members belong?
- 5. How have various family members contributed and served in their churches and communities because of their faith?

RESEARCH MORE

- Discover if any of your family members have created a genealogy or a family tree.
- Research the various cultures represented in your family tree.
- Interview more family members!
