

Kris Cap

SKILL LEVEL: Intermediate **YARN WEIGHT:** Worsted **SIZE:** One Size - 204 yds

Featured Yarn: Urban Silk by skacel collection, Inc., 80% Silk, 20% Cotton, 102 yds / 50g. Shown in Color #19.

Also required: 16" addi Turbo® circular needle in size 4 mm (approx US 6), or size needed to obtain gauge; double point needles in same size; tapestry needle.

All yarn and needles distributed by skacel collection, Inc.

GAUGE:

20 sts and 29 rows = 4" x 4" in Rev St st.

To save time, check your gauge and read all instructions thoroughly before beginning.

INSTRUCTIONS:

CO 11 sts.

Work 19 rows of Earflap Chart (Row 1 is a WS row). Move sts to DPN, and make a second earflap and leave on needle.

Turn and work in Rev St st to center 9 sts of earflap (this is the cable – see Cable Chart) work Row 4 of cable chart, work in Rev St st to end of flap, CO 24 sts, join 2nd earflap and work center 9 sts in Rev St st, work Row 4 of Cable Chart, work in Rev St st to end of second earflap, CO 36 sts, join into round, being careful not to twist = 96 sts.

Cont pat as set, working cable pattern with Rev st st sections until hat meas 5.5" from start of hat after earflaps.

Decrease for crown:

Work to start of first cable, this now becomes the beginning of the round. Work as follows, changing to DPNs as needed:

Rnd 1: Work Cable Chart, (p4, p2tog) 6x, work Cable Chart, (p4, p2tog) 8x = 84 sts.

Rnd 2: Work Cable Chart, p30, work Cable Chart, p40.

Rnd 3: Work Cable Chart, (p3, p2tog) 6x, work Cable Chart, (p3, p2tog) 8x = 70 sts.

Rnd 4: Work Cable Chart, p24, work Cable Chart, p32

Rnd 5: Work Cable Chart, (p2, p2tog) 6x, work Cable Chart, (p2, p2tog) 8x = 56 sts.

Rnd 6: Work Cable Chart, p18, work Cable Chart, p24.

Rnd 7: Work Cable Chart, (p1, p2tog) 6x, work Cable Chart, (p1, p2tog) 8x = 42 sts.

Rnd 8: Work Cable Chart, p12, work Cable Chart, p16.

Rnd 9: K3tog, (k2tog) 3x, (p2tog) 6x, k3tog, (k2tog) 3x, (p2tog) 8x = 22sts.

Rnd 10: (K2tog) 2x, (p2tog) 3x, (k2tog) 2x, (p2tog) 4x = 11 sts. Break yarn, thread through remaining sts. Pull tight. Weave in all ends.

Braided Ties:

Cut 18 lengths of yarn 16 inches long, or desired length. Using a crochet hook, attach 3 groups of 3 to bottom of each earflap, as for fringe. Braid each tail, and tie off. Trim ends, so that they are even.

CABLE STITCHES:

2/2RC slip 2 stitches on cable needle and hold in back

of work, k2, then k2 from cable needle.

2/2LC slip 2 stitches on cable needle and hold in front of

work, k2, then k2 from cable needle.

1/2RPC slip 1 stitch on cable needle and hold in back of

work, k2, then p1 from cable needle.

2/1LPC slip 2 stitches on cable needle and hold in back

of work, p1, then k2 from cable needle.

+ = kfb




