Henry du Yore Straight Bourbon

The Story: Henry Duyore's Bourbon is an ultra premium American Whiskey that is at least 51% corn, but heavy on Rye, with a liberal amount of Barley to give greater depth to the aromatics and to add greater viscosity and fatness to the palate. The effect of the different mash bills and blending yields a whiskey that is somewhere between Bourbon, Rye and a Single Malt, while still representing the best that a Bourbon can be.

The Spirit: Mash Bills(in decending order): Corn, Rye, Barley

Aging: Minimum 4 years, some double wooding

Cooperage: Mixed Bourbon American oak, and French oak

Distillery: Our distillery is perched in the hills of North West Oregon where the slim line between man and nature keeps a balanced divide that reminds us of the beauty and struggle to tame the wild, and craft exceptional spirits. We distill in a 300 gallon Pruehlo Cognac copper pot in order to retain the deepest aromatics of our distillate with superlative texture.

Although Henry Duyore is now completely reformed, his true identity cannot be revealed. He prefers to stay near his cabin while enjoying hunting, whittling, reading classic literature, and the occasional nip of good whiskey.
