### **General Changes**

What's Changing?	Recommended Actions
<b>A bold new look for NetSuite</b> The new UI is clean, simple, and intuitive.	If you have customizations — especially client- side SuiteScript — test them thoroughly. Contact your account manager or file a support case if you discover problems. This exciting new UI works best in the latest browser versions. For more information, see <u>Supported Browsers for NetSuite</u> .
SuiteScripts that directly access the NetSuite DOM may no longer work SuiteScript has never officially supported direct access to the DOM. If your scripts are accessing the DOM, they may no longer work as expected in Version 2014 Release 2.	Test your scripts in Release Preview and, if needed, take corrective action to ensure your SuiteScripts work in Version 2014 Release 2. Check your custom HTML and scripts, and validate their compatibility with HTML5 standards.
Quirks mode turned off in Version 2014 Release 2 Quirks mode allows backward compatibility with older browsers instead of complying with W3C and IETF standards in standards mode.	Check your custom HTML and scripts, and validate that they are working as expected in Release Preview.
<b>Expanded functionality and new look for</b> <b>addresses</b> Addresses on Entity, Transaction, Subsidiary, Location, and Workplace record types now support custom forms and custom fields. Full support for customization enables address formats to be tailored to specific countries and business requirements.	Set up a custom address form for each country. On each custom address form you can include custom fields to store country-specific address data, rearrange fields to be in the expected order for each country, and make fields mandatory to ensure correct data entry. When a user views or edits an address in your account, the fields that display in the popup are determined by the custom address form you
A new address popup makes it easier for users to view and edit address field values.	have associated with the selected country.



What's Changing?	Recommended Actions
<b>Expanded functionality for addresses may</b> <b>impact some SuiteScripts and workflows</b> Although the new address functionality is largely backwards compatible, it includes some changes to SuiteScript and SuiteFlow address support that may impact a small number of existing scripts and workflows, causing unexpected results in Version 2014 Release 2.	Review the help topic <u>SuiteScript and SuiteFlow</u> <u>Impact of Version 2014 Release 2 Address</u> <u>Customization Changes</u> , and determine if any of the listed impacts affect your account. Make the required changes to affected scripts in your Version 2014 Release 2 Release Preview account, and fully test these scripts in this environment before the upgrade of your production account. You can then make these changes in your production account immediately after upgrade. The NetSuite Customer Support team is available to assist you in making these changes.
<b>Spell Checker deprecated</b> All supported browsers include a feature that checks the spelling of words in most text fields. NetSuite's spell checker is no longer needed. The associated user preference has also been removed.	Spell checking is usually enabled by default in browsers. Check the documentation for your browser for more information.

### **API Changes**

What's Changing?	Recommended Actions
Color Theme API deprecated New standard colors and themes replace the previous standard themes for the UI. nlobjContext.getColorPreferences() is deprecated. nlobjConfiguration is deprecated for COLORTHEME, HUE, SAT, and LUM.	For backward compatibility, we have mapped old color theme colors to new colors. Your web store theme customizations are not affected.
<b>addPageLink()</b> Cross links have been moved to the More menu in the upper right.	

## **Visual Changes**

What's Changing?	Recommended Actions
<b>Default Font Change</b> The new default font is Open Sans.	Update any custom UI with the new font and larger font size to match the new UI.
<b>Labels above Fields</b> The labels for fields now appear above the fields.	Review your custom forms. You may want to make changes to layout or spacing so that your form customizations look their best with the new UI.
Quick Selector Portlet	
This is now the Dashboard View Filter rather than a portlet. To open it, click the link on the upper right of the dashboard that says "Portlet date settings." After you select your options, the link text changes to display them.	
Set Preferences > Appearance > Styles The Zoom dropdown list has been removed.	Instead, users can zoom using browser functions (Ctrl+Plus Sign or Ctrl+Minus Sign) in Chrome and Firefox.
	Chrome with 90% zoom is recommended for users who prefer a denser layout.
	A new user preference has been added to control the density for Internet Explorer 10 and higher.



What's Changing?	Recommended Actions
<b>Improved Color Themes</b> Custom color themes are no longer supported for users who are customizing the UI. Custom color themes are still supported in the web store.	Color themes that were previously selected will automatically be mapped to the closest new color theme.
Set Preferences > Appearance > Centers & Dashboards	
The Documents tab always shows the File Cabinet, and the Setup tab always shows the Setup Manager. The dashboard options for these tabs have been removed.	
The New Bar has moved to the Create New menu on the global header. The preferences related to the New Bar have been removed.	
<b>Custom Logo</b> The logo region is now 144 x 30 px.	Your custom logo will be resized automatically to fit the logo region with the aspect ratio maintained.
