* Why Solid Brass?

We use solid brass for its traditional quality and its natural resistance to corrosion. The brass components of this product have been lightly oxidized to enhance its beauty and advance the natural aging process. Left alone, it will attain a rich dark patina. We did not apply a protective coating to the surfaces of this product because there is no clear coating that lasts as long as the raw metal itself. If you prefer the bright look of polished brass, feel free to polish the components by hand occasionally.

* Ideal Rain Gauge Placement

For an accurate measurement of rainfall, place your rain gauge in an open area away from overhanging trees and approximately ten feet from buildings.

★ Avoid Freezing!

Be sure to bring in your rain gauge before air temperatures reach the freezing point. This will keep it safely free of ice which can expand and break the vial.
