7	Pattern 3	Back	Cont in pats as established, working <i>28 rows</i> 2 times, then cont to rep rows 25 and 26 only.	Cont in pats as established, working <b>24 rows</b> 2 times, then cont to rep rows 25 and 26 only
13	Pattern 6	Back	Instructions on how to use chart are confusing	ON RS, when knitting chart it tells you to knit A-B , then P1, K2, P1(This is part B –C)  The WS row is not written out, as an example, row 2 is written out below:  Row 2 : 1 selvage stitch, P1, K2, *P2, K2 rep from * 2(3/4) times, from arrow D to C 2 times, K1, P2, K1, from arrow B to A 2 times, *K2, P2 rep from * 2(3/4) times, K2, P1, 1 selvage stitch.
33	Pattern 15	Open work Pattern	Row 2: 1 selvage stitch, P1, *K2tog, yo, P2; rep from *, end K2tog, P1, 1 selvage stitch	Row 2: 1 selvage stitch, P1, *K2tog, yo, P2; rep from *, end K2tog, <b>yo</b> , P1, 1 selvage stitch
