

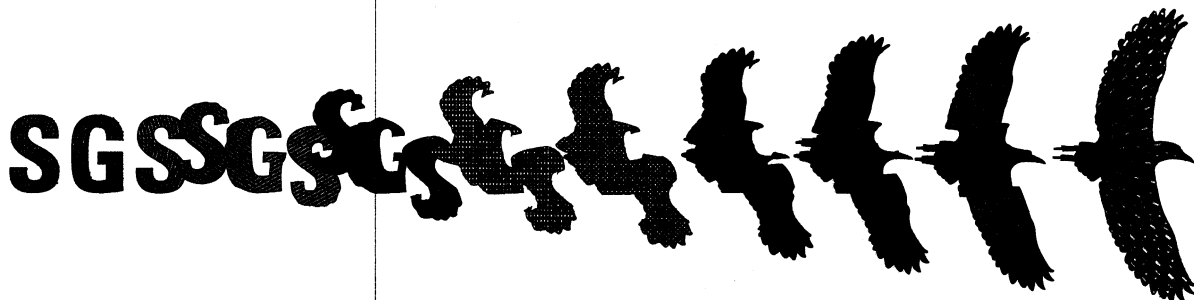

PPE Product

3M model 4510 Coverall; manufactured with a spunbond polypropylene fabric laminated with a polyethylene film. The coverall has elasticated hood, waist, wrists and ankles, the seams are sewn and internally bound. The suit is supplied in six nominal sizes.

It is certified that the manufacturer's technical file and the above mentioned PPE have been assessed and found to be in accordance with the requirements of Council Directive 89/686/EEC. When examined the PPE satisfied the relevant requirements of the harmonized standards, EN 1073-2:2002 Class 1 Non Ventilated Protective Clothing against Radioactive Contamination, EN 13034:2005 Type 6 Protective clothing against liquid chemicals & EN ISO 13982-1:2004 Type 5 Protective clothing for use against solid particulates, In addition the fabric met the requirements of EN 1149-5:2008 for electrostatic dissipative protective clothing.

The manufacturer's information notice (3M 4510 User Instructions Issue 1) contained within the technical file in English has been inspected and found to have addressed all of the relevant requirements of the standards. However, the detailed content of the information notice is the responsibility of the manufacturer, as are translations into other languages.
