

At Work with God

God Is Awesome!

Use this dramatic recitation to help students learn God's attributes. It is divided into easy-to-learn sections that correspond to each lesson. Rehearse the dialogue and hand-signs together, adding the portion that goes with each new lesson you teach. You may want to use this narration as a presentation to parents or other classes at the end of the quarter.

Teacher: What is God like?

Children: God is awesome!

Lesson 1: God is Good

He stands for all that's best. (stand erect, smile, and nod head)

Lesson 2: God is Patient

He waits for us to grow. (squat and slowly rise to full height)

Lesson 3: God is Righteous

He always does what's right. (two thumbs up)

Lesson 4: God is Faithful

He never lets us down. (smile and move head from side-to-side)

Lesson 5: God is All-Seeing

He doesn't miss a thing. (place hand above eyes, searching the room)

Lesson 6: God is All-Knowing

He knows us inside out. ("inside"—tap shoulders; "out"—spread arms wide)

Lesson 7: God is the Good Shepherd

He keeps us satisfied. (pat stomach)

Lesson 8: God is Victorious

He always wins the day. (clasp hands over head, pump up and down)

Lesson 9: God is the True Vine

He grows good fruit through us. (pretend to be a tree)

Lesson 10: God is the Lord of Hosts

He rules angels above. (salute)

Lesson 11: God is Fair

He treats us all the same. (nod and point to each other)

Lesson 12: God is Holy

He's pure in every way. (shield eyes from brightness)
