

God Is Wonderful!

Use this dramatic recitation to help students learn God's attributes. It is divided into easy-to-learn sections that correspond to each lesson. Rehearse the dialogue and hand-signs together, adding the portion that goes with each new lesson you teach. You may want to use this narration as a presentation to parents or other classes at the end of the quarter.

Teacher: What is God like? **Children:** God is wonderful!

Lesson 1: God is Three-in-One

He's Spirit, Father, and Son. (hold up one finger (Spirit), two (Father), and three (Son))

Lesson 2: God is the only Way

Christ holds the key to heaven. (open door, peek inside)

Lesson 3: God is Unchanging

He always stays the same. (nod head up and down)

Lesson 4: God is Love

He gave His only Son. (wrap arms around self)

Lesson 5: God is the Redeemer

Christ paid for all our sins. (form a cross with arms, then bow head)

Lesson 6: God is Perfect

He never makes mistakes. (move head side-to-side signifying "no")

Lesson 7: God is the Provider

He always meets our needs. (raise hands with palms facing you, then lower hands)

Lesson 8: God is the Healer

He cares for all the sick. (feel pulse in wrist)

Lesson 9: God is the Protector

He shields us from all harm. (hold up imaginary shield)

Lesson 10: God is Judge

He decides what's right and wrong. (pound on table with gavel)

Lesson 11: God is the Bridegroom

He'll make the Church His Bride. (link arms, bow down)

Lesson 12: God is Eternal

He doesn't begin or end. (move arm in unending circle)
