A: The only bridge to life.

Q: What do people obey if they know God? (L2)

A: His commands.

Q: What do people who don't know God feel toward their brothers? (L2)

A: They feel hate.

Q: Complete this sentence: "We either love God or we love _____." (L3)

A: The world.

Q: What is God's "test"? (L3)

A: Whom do you love?

Q: What happens to everyone who crosses the bridge? (L4)

A: God changes him or her.

Q: What does everyone who believes in Jesus become? (L4)

A: God's own child.
