
DiscipleIand Memory Formula

Develop a good habit! Use this formula to memorize Bible verses:

$\mathbf{T} + \mathbf{R} + \mathbf{V} + \mathbf{R}$

- T-topic "Jesus Arrives"
- R—reference "Luke 2:11"
- V—verse "For today in the city of David..."
- R—reference "Luke 2:11"

Memorize the topic (T) and reference (R) as if they are part of the verse. Learning them together will help you remember where to find the verse in the Bible. Plus, you will be able to recall one important truth that each verse teaches. Every time you review verses and when you learn new verses, recite the topic and reference, too!
