

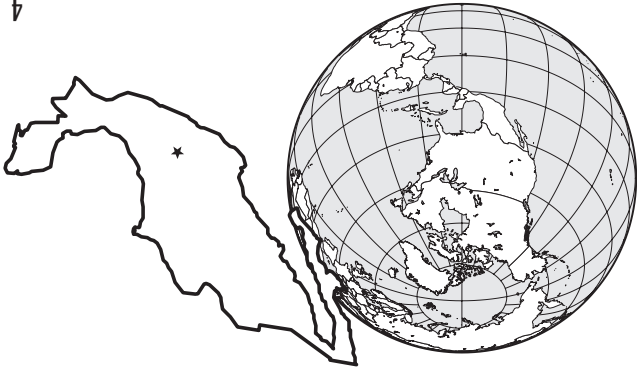
MY BIG-SCREEN ADVENTURE PASSPORT TEMPLATE

Print the first page and then print the second page on the reverse side of the first. Repeat this process with the third and fourth pages. Cut each sheet of paper in half lengthwise.

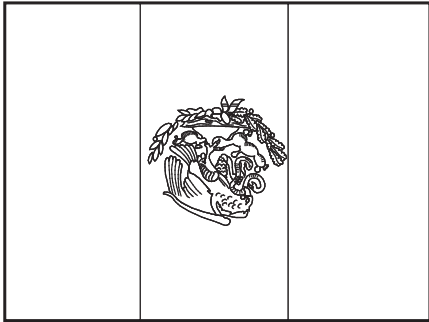
Assemble the resulting pages into the correct page order and fold in half. Staple along the fold. Trim to size.
