



Sock Yarn Baby Booties

A complimentary **skacel collection, Inc.** pattern.

SKILL LEVEL: Intermediate

SIZE AND MATERIALS:

One Size: Infant. Finished length 3.75".

Featured Yarn:

70 yds of sock yarn (Shown in Trekking XXL)

Also Required:

addi Turbo® needles in size 3mm (approx US 2) or size needed to obtain gauge, tapestry needle.

All yarn and needles distributed by skacel collection, Inc.

Seed Stitch Pattern:

Row 1(WS): * K1, P1; rep from * across

Rows 2 & 4: Knit the knits, and purl the purls

Row 3: * P1, K1; rep from * across

GAUGE: 7sts and 8 rows = 1" in seed stitch pattern

To save time, please check your gauge and read all instructions thoroughly before beginning.

INSTRUCTIONS:

CO 56 sts. Work in seed stitch pattern for 2". BO 12 sts at beg of next 2 rows (32 sts). Continue working in pattern until bootie measures 3.75". End with pattern row 2 or 4.

Toe Decrease:

Row 1 (WS): * P2tog; rep from * across

Rows 2 & 4: Purl across

Dec Row 3: * K2tog; rep from * across

Finishing:

Cut yarn, leaving 8" tail. Fold bootie in half with WS together; cast on edge is back of bootie heel. With tapestry needle, thread yarn through rem sts and secure. Continue sewing up front top of bootie to point where sts were bound off. Sew back seam. Make I-cord (see directions below) and sew to back seam under cuff. Fold down cuff 1" and sew cuff to bootie. Tie I-cord and weave in all ends.

Directions for I-cord:

CO 3 sts. * K3, replace onto left-hand needle, and rep from * until I-cord measures 9.5" from beg for tying a knot or 15" from beg for tying a bow. Cut yarn and weave in ends.

P2tog	purl 2 stitches together as one
